**OUR ACTIVITIES ARE FOCUSED ON EDUCATION ABOUT** SEXUAL HEALTH. THEY ARE BASED ON A CONSTRUCTIVE AND COMPREHENSIVE APPROACH TO HUMAN RELATIONSHIPS, SEXUAL BEHAVIOUR AND REPRODUCTION, IN THE RESPECT OF HUMAN RIGHTS.



- Laboratory of reflection and strategies: "Think tanks".
- Elaboration of pilot training modules for policy makers and professionals
- Organization of innovation days in education and research.
- Organization of innovation awards in education and research.
- Participation in expert groups in specialized agencies of the United Nations including WHO.
- Development of International Scientific Interdisciplinary Committee.



- Intervention in national and international congresses.
- Promotion of Sexual Health in partnership with academic and civil societies.
- Publication and distribution of books and articles.
- Promotion of human rights in collaboration with international agencies. academic and civil societies.
